CHRISANDTHECAPPER chased the pacesetter two to three wide on the turn, closed in rapidly on that rival coming to the quarter pole, overhauled a leg weary foe and took charge a sixteenth down the road, drew off decisively, hand urged to the end. ABLE BAKER CHARLIE already under strong handling taking the four path for entrance into the stretch, rallied for the place. BEDOUIN NOW off the inside, was under a full drive entering the stretch, got outfinished. ABRA off an alert beginning, quickly established control, was guided over to the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, was kept to a rating hold by the pilot while showing the way, had the winner burst upon the scene as a major danger prior to the quarter pole, showed signs of leg weariness getting run down shortly afterwards and retreated. GREEN GRATTO gunned from the starting gate, got outrun for the early advantage by ABRA nonetheless, that rival having to use little more than his own power to achieve the front end, remained under some encouragement giving chase on that opponent from off the rail, tired. IN TODD WE TRUST failed to menace. FASTINOV took an awkward first step, ducked in sharply and was outrun thereafter. FUSCHERO in a bit at the start, was given a tug on the left rein and put back on a truer course, saved ground on the turn and faltered. MOONLITE ENCOUNTER acted up, was backed out, remounted and reloaded, had barely settled back into the stall comfortably when the gate was sprung open, proceeded to lunge then got carried inward by an errant FESTINOV, went on to trail while taking the inside route before coming out sharply in a display of greenness during the final stages.
