CAPE COD CAROL departed the backstretch from the three path, arrived at the five-sixteenths marker and was set down, instantly picked up the pace, challenged in earnest and grabbed a narrow advantage spinning into the lane, with the second place finisher bottled up in traffic down along the rail, drew off proceeding her way down the lane, kept busy to the end. POP POP'S SMYLE settled along the inside route during the initial stages, was nearly halfway around the turn when asked for run, responded to the encouragement and scurried into contention, was closing in precariously up to WARRIOR MARIE's heels, when forced to check nearing the quarter pole, losing some ground and momentum, found enough space to ease into the two path at the top of the lane, rallied willingly to procure the place. HURRICANE KITTEN saved ground for nearly a half, came four wide into upper stretch having already been to solid encouragement and mustered up a mild response to take the show. NINE LOVES in slightly at the start, was pulled off another to prevent any contact from being made, was three wide entering the turn and five wide exiting it, failed to rally appreciably. WARRIOR MARIE was lightly hand urged en route to grabbing the early advantage, vied briefly with the main pursuer then edged away sufficiently and quickly tucked along the rail, showed the way, well rated for the opening half, came under heavy pressure nearing the quarter pole, was let out, yet readily succumbed, tired steadily running down the stretch. SO FASHION off a beat slowly, saved ground until the quarter pole. SWEET MAXINE along the outside, briefly sparred with the early pacesetter, was taken in hand and eased back before reaching the half mile pole, chased that rival under some urging on the turn and tired after completing a half.
