Footnotes

DON TITO was guided over to the inside route, gained ground readily on the wayward LUCKSDREAM during the run the bend, cut the corner under a full drive and with a full head of steam, was the innermost of a threesome fighting for command during the final sixteenth, got the job at the finish line. LUCKYSDREAM shook free of the others proceeding the backstretch, drifted into the three path with the rider attempting to counteract it with a snug grip on the left rein, remained well off the inside racing around the bend, with the rider attempting some light stick work in the area of the right shoulder then flashing the whip from the same side, all practically for naught, arrived at the quarter pole having squandered all but a sliver of what had been a comfortable advantage, and with rivals in close proximity [poised to strike both from the rail and to the outside, clung tenaciously to the top during the ensuing furlong, battled gamely from between rivals in the last sixteenth but got nipped. B SHANNY gave chase from the two path on the turn, commenced the stretch three wide, was the outermost member of a three-way tussle for the lead during the final sixteenth, fell short. HACKLETON was quickly placed along the rail, put up interest noticeably approaching the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch, gained ground well, although never posing a serious threat. KINGSFORD DRIVE broke to the outside, departed the backstretch from the three path, folded.
