DARRIN'S DILEMMA broke alertly to take control, was well rated laying down the fractions while taking the inside route, safely maintained some daylight throughout the run around the bend from a more energetically-handled rival, was put to a mild hand ride coming to the three-sixteenths pole and went on draw away to a convincing score. BELSO WILD off awkwardly, was grabbed hold of to prevent ducking inward, got put back on a straight course and was rushed up into a forward position, gave chase on the top one, at first under coaxing, and then under much stronger encouragement, just past the three-eighths pole, could make no headway on that opponent, lost contact after turning into the stretch, but came home with good energy nonetheless to be second best. MOLLY'S SHIP was taken in hand after breaking outward a couple of paths leaving the gate, was put to a brisk hand ride down the backstretch, raced well off the inside on the turn, swung five wide into upper stretch and rallied well enough to be along for the show. WARRIOR UP slipped off the inside leaving the five-sixteenths pole and had no rally. TINDARO'S PROSPECT tracked inside and tired. ZEPPE was through after going a half.
