Footnotes

SLIGHTLY STUNNED gave chase three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and continued to close the gap gradually on the front runner, successfully wore down that opponent with about a sixteenth to go and edged away, kept busy to the end. POGONIA contested the pace from the outside, needed only light encouragement to wrest away command from a much more energetically-handled foe nearing the quarter pole, went a little distance longer before being put to a drive, got overtaken in deep stretch but held well enough to procure the place. MISTRETTA unhurried for nearly a half, fanned five wide into upper stretch, displayed good, but belatedly energy down the center of the course to grab the show. EXPECT GOOD NEWS off the inside, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, took the four path into the lane and rallied mildly en route for the last major slice of the pot. MISS SILVER BIRCH came inward, making light contact with PAVE THE WAY at the break, took the inside route, advanced steadily in the right direction during the stretch run, altered course to move around a tiring rival at the sixteenth pole, and continued onward for minor spoils in the end. PAVE THE WAY got away last, after being brushed by MISS SILVER BIRCH and carried inward a couple of paths leaving the starting gate, was almost immediately put back on course and rushed up along the rail to grab the early lead, argued for control during the run around the bend, fell back leaving the five-sixteenths pole despite being pushed along by the pilot and steadily tired thereafter. LA CHIQUILINA lightly bumped at the start, raced along

the outside and was through after completing a half. THAT'S THE MOVE brushed with the rival breaking directly to the outside, was never involved. HALO CITY GIRL three wide to four wide on the turn, had little left of the stretch drive. CINNAMON STICK displayed brief foot.
