### Footnotes

LE BERNARDIN quickly cleared the field to grab command and was guided over to the inside, showed the way from there, feeling some pressure from MR. BEER GOGGLES all the while, safely fended that foe off and got called upon turning for home, felt the presence of the runner up with an eighth to go, dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. WILD TARGET ranged up on the front runners during the run around the bend, was placed three wide in preparation for the stretch run, entered the lane and was put to a drive, took aim on the winner, positioned just off that rival's hindquarters in midstretch, failed to cut into margin significantly thereafter. MR. BEER GOGGLES prompted the top one from the outside for a half before backing away. TACTICAL SAENZ towards the inside, was through after going a half. UNYIELDING bobbled slightly at the break, rode the rail for a furlong commencing from the seven-sixteenths pole, came up empty. AWAITED came out a couple of steps leaving the starting gate, departed the backstretch from the three path, offered little.
