Footnotes

CAUSE I CAN was yanked hard off CON THE CAT leaving the starting gate, raced three wide around both turns, swept past the front runners with a bold move on the far turn to take over by the five-sixteenths pole, needing only the mildest of coaxing to achieve the goal, turned for home and was called upon, lengthened the advantage during the ensuing furlong, held off the lone potential threat in the last eighth, while drifting well out towards the middle of the strip. HURRICANE HEAT advanced in tandem with DONTSTEALMYLAND down the homestretch, jostled and bumped with the aforementioned rival when in tight off heels shortly before reaching the first turn, continued from off the rail thereafter, took the three path around the far turn having put to a prolonged drive, finished well enough to be substantially clear of the others for place honors. CON THE CAT unhurried for a half, picked up the pace slightly upon departing the backstretch, narrowed the gap in hand and mostly three wide on the second turn, paused in the three path coming to the quarter pole, got set down after being settled into upper stretch, lacked the necessary response. FREGATA travelled three wide on the opening bend, remained on course at a considerable distance from the rail the rest of the way and went on to best the rest. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH contested the pace from between opponents for six furlongs then gave way. CALGARY ENFORCER argued for control taking the inside route for three-quarters, tired. GAMBLIN FEVER made a three wide run to take up the role of stalker, applied some pressure on the leader, as the widest of a threesome for almost six furlongs before backing away. DONTSTEALMYLAND in tight quarters approaching the first turn, hit the rail after bumping with the runner up, wilted off the subsequent ground-saving journey and was eased in the final furlong.
