HARDENED WILDCAT patiently handled by the rider, loped along at the back in the initial stages, found his stride nearing the end of the backstretch and took off with a rail run around the turn to cut down to size the early lengthy disadvantage, spun four wide into the stretch full of momentum, went a few strides before tipped into the five path in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole for optimal racing clearance, gained ground readily making his way to the eighth pole, overtook the front runners with about a sixteenth remaining, and kicked well clear, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. BEGGARTHYNEIGHBOR broke alertly, applied pressure on the pacesetter while attending from the two path, turned for home and was let out, battled on nearly even terms with HOW DO I WIN, poked a head in front for two jumps in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, proved powerless to stave off the winner, but continued on willingly to garner the place. HOW DO I WIN was hand urged to the front, remained under some light urging setting the opening splits from the rail, was called upon in response to intensified pressure heading for the top of the lane, got hooked up in an intense stretch duel with the runner up, finally succumbed to that opponent's pressure and weakened in the final sixteenth. COPY MY SWAGGER raced along the outside under a firm hold until the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty for the stretch drive. CHRISTOPHER'S JOY was put to some coaxing to keep pace while taking the inside route on the turn, cut the corner under much stronger encouragement, failed to fire. ANCIENT ROME underwent a three wide pursuit, folded.
