CITY GONE WILD assumed the role of primary pursuer after the start, stalked the runner up, hand urged while undergoing the task, ranged up and drew abreast coming to the five-sixteenths marker, got called upon as did CHLOE BEAR, entered the stretch still on even terms with that opponent, forged to the front, by a long head or so with a furlong to go, added to the margin inch by inch the rest of the way, kept to the task at hand. CHLOE BEAR quickly established control and made it over to the rail with room to spare before reaching the end of the homestretch, rated kindly while setting a pair of moderate opening splits, had the eventual winner issue a challenge in earnest late on the far turn, was called upon, batted heads apart from there to midstretch, having relinquished, albeit by only a bare margin in the meanwhile, continued onward willingly but had to settle for the place. CURRENT EVENT saved ground until the quarter pole and proved no match for the top twosome. LOUDER THAN SOUND driven three wide into the stretch, made no headway on the front runners. LARA made contact with the left side of the starting gate, settled along the outside within range of the front runners, had the pilot release a firm hold on the reins in the vicinity of the half mile pole, was put to solid encouragement a furlong later, tired.
