### Footnotes

DEMON'S DEPUTY lightly bumped a short distance out of the starting gate, was sent over to the inside, saved ground for nearly the entire way around the bend, was released from a good hold by the pilot and sharply angled three wide into the stretch, gained readily during the ensuing furlong, continued onward, collaring the victor of the earlier pace dispute in the very late stages. TIGHTEND TOUCHDOWN reacting to pressure coming from the innermost breaker, made contact with FRISKY WARRIOR several strides into the event, motored up draw even with the front runners halfway down the backstretch, argued for command with HANNIBAL LECTER while saving ground, shook free of that nemesis heading for the quarter pole, drew out to emerge from the furlong grounds in possession of his biggest advantage, had it cut down steadily by the winner thereafter, dug in with good determination but got caught late. BLUE CREEK sluggish in the early going, picked up the pace upon reaching the turn, raced three wide for a good portion of the way around it, swung about five wide into upper stretch, came home with good energy en route for the show. FRISKY WARRIOR bumped with the runner up a couple of jumps after departing the gate, quickly tucked along the rail and rode it for almost a half, was given his cue at the head of the stretch and responded instantly, displayed good late foot down the center of the strip to take the final major slice of the pot. HANNIBAL LECTER sparred for command from the two path for a half and gave way. P J'S MAGICAL WINK vacated the inside route midway on the turn, lacked the needed response. STONECOLDSTEAMER raced along the outside and tired. DECISIVE MOVE briefly sparred with HANNIBAL LECTER, had the second place finisher arrive on the scene and was taken back, fell back considerably leaving the half mile pole, got put to encouragement to no avail and gave way after turning for home.
