Footnotes

FLO'S GREATNESS tracked inside just off the pace, came under encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, rallied down along the rail to challenge at the sixteenth marker, took command seventy yards from home kept busy to prevail. DAN'S GOLD forwardly placed three wide in close pursuit, came under a drive three furlongs out, spun four wide for home, rallied willingly to take over a furlong out, dug in under a drive with good energy, got displaced seventy yards from home while safe for the place honors. CHRISTOPHER'S JOY urged to the front, set a solid pace from just off the inside, got let out at the head of the stretch, yielded the lead a furlong out, fought on to the sixteenth marker before weakening in the late stages while clear for the show. DABA DABA urged along from the get go chasing inside, angled three wide for home bidding mildly in upper stretch before weakening in the final furlong. WANSTEAD fractious in the gate prior to the start, threw his head at the start getting off slow conceding five to six lengths to the front, chased from the rear well off the inside, took the overland route through the turn getting ridden along from midway, continued five to six wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals in the drive. TOP YANK away well from the gate, settled just off the inside towards the rear initially, chased three to four wide in the turn urged along from midway, swung five wide for home and offered no response. LITTLE DALE leapt slightly at the break getting off half a beat slow, chased four to five wide throughout placed to a drive at the five-sixteenths and tired. COPY MY SWAGGER four wide in mid pack early on, appeared to be trying to get out midway on the turn, had the rider shift inside a path soon after commencing a drive at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide for home and tired.
