GAME TOKEN sat reserved in the two path for the opening half, turned for home and was kept on hold during the earlier stages of the stretch run, espied a developing hole and was sent towards it, split rivals at the eighth pole, continued onward, collared the leader in the final seventy yards and edged away. POPPA'S PICK appeared somewhat rank almost from the get-go, noticeably offering resistance to the hold being applied by the rider by pulling and fighting against the bit, saw clearance down along the inside nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and dove towards it, tracked the front runners from thereafter, still not rating kindly, was put to a firm hold approaching the quarter pole, lacking sufficient rail clearance at this juncture, made his way from upper to midstretch, still not fully clear and sill kept in reserve, was given his cue and accelerated up to join DEERSLAYER as that rival drifted out slightly, coming to the eighth pole, had the lead within two strides later, got reeled in by the top one in deep stretch and had to settle for the place. WESTERN TEASE was under encouragement coming three wide into the stretch and displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to secure the show. DEERSLAYER argued for control from the rail, came under heavy pressure by the head of the stretch, fought well before relinquishing just past the furlong marker. AL'S LARK got bumped at the start, was placed three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. SEEKING ANITA broke slightly to the outside and failed to reach a contending position. QUICK MONEY bumped with AL'S LARK leaving the starting gate, prompted the pacesetter two wide for a half and gave way.
