Footnotes

SIXTY ACRES brushed the gate on her right side at the start, set the pace under a light hold along the inside, was let out at the three-sixteenths pole and drew away under a mild hand ride, had the rider take a glance back before gearing her down in the final sixteenth to win comfortably. SOLDIERETTE pressed the pace from the two path, was set down at the quarter pole, proved no match for the aforementioned rival while continuing on a clear second best. OUR FAVORITE tracked the pace in behind from inside, saved ground through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, was further engaged by the rider swinging for home, couldn't match strides with the top pair through the lane while holding onto the show spot safely. LUCK IN THE CITY out sprinted early on, saved ground until the three-sixteenth, angled out at that station rallying by tired foes for the last major share. DONNA'S SANDEE raced four to five wide through the turn while at the back of the pack, gradually angled to the rail after straightening for home while offering little. AUSALE CHASM stumbled at the start, was hustled soon after to attempt to establish a forward position, came under a drive midway on the turn and weakened thereafter.
