CREAM CREEK was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and continued on to hold the place spot. PRINCESS PETRIZZO chased the pace from the outside and lacked a rally. BUDAPEST GIRL chased the pace along the inside and had no rally. DYNAMIC PIC raced three wide and had no rally. JET SET JAZZ was bumped after the start and had no rally. RINGALING stumbled after the start, was bumped and was taken up then raced inside and tired. PERSONAL JEWEL was bumped after the start, was taken up, dropped back and tired. MISS BALOO chased the pace while three wide, bore out on the turn and was eased in the stretch.
