Footnotes

FULL OF SCOUNDRELS was steadied after lunging at the break, quickly recovered and settled into stride, took up position near midpack along the inside, gradually worked his way forward during the run around the bend, was taken off the inside to clear a tiring rival coming to the quarter pole, altered outward an additional path or two about a sixteenth down the road, gained readily on the front runners, drove to the lead through the huge opening between the aforementioned foes in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away under hand encouragement. DIGITAL JOE bobbed at the start, but took up a good forward position nonetheless, left the backstretch three wide, both soon tucked into two path, bided time while abreast of the leader before making his move leaving the three-eighths pole, went head to head with VISION OF MAGIC from the five-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole, had just put that one away when the top one went scurrying by, but dug deep down to salvage place honors. LOYAL LEADER raced within range along the outside, angled four wide for the stretch drive and had a good finish down the center of the strip en route for the show. VISION OF MAGIC contested the lead almost from the get-go, at first from the two path, then from the rail, after clearing over to the inside at the seven-sixteenths pole, duelled with the runner up on nearly even terms from the five-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole before backing away. BILL SENIOR came inward, bumping with SPENCERIFIC and bothering both that

foe as well BROOKLYN BOUND, chased three wide around the turn, was fully roused by the five-sixteenths pole and tired. SPENCERIFIC bobbed, then was forced to steady after bumping with BILL SENIOR about a jump later, failed to overcome that rough beginning. ISN'TLOVEJUSTGRAND unseated the rider during the post parade and ran off a considerable distance before being apprehended by the outrider, proceeded to come away in good order, raced three wide around the turn, was asked for a response just past the five-sixteenths pole, but had little left to offer. NANA'S TOKEN briefly vied for the lead along the inside and wilted. BROOKLYN BOUND bothered at the start, was always outrun.
