VIABLE attempted to duck inward leaving the starting gate, but was grabbed hold and pulled off the nearest opponent in time to avoid contact, recovered and went on to assume a forward position, chased the pacesetter from the outside, began to close the gap from the seven-sixteenths pole, with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve, was asked for a response after turning for home, made up additional ground during the run through the furlong grounds, drawing alongside the leader at the eighth pole, continued onward, wrested away the lead a sixteenth down the road and edged away under good handling. BARNIE'S BULLET sped off from the competition, lightly coaxed, showed the way on an open lead, placed towards the inside, was let out soon after entering the stretch, felt the top one's presence by the furlong marker, offered good resistance during the ensuing sixteenth before relinquishing the front, but held willingly to procure the place. GREEN BANANAS was taken in hand after being lightly bumped at the start, raced three wide around the turn and rallied with good energy to grab the show. MR. HADIF veered in sharply leaving the starting gate, compromising in various degrees most of the rivals breaking to his left side, underwent a three wide pursuit and weakened during the final furlong. DONTQUITYOURDAYJOB lightly bumped at the start, left the backstretch three wide, sat within striking distance throughout the run around the bend, was called upon after entering the stretch but lacked the needed response. ADMIRALTY raced towards the two path and failed to reach a contending position. SCALE steadied at the start, moved up into midpack soon afterwards, made a mild bid to the eighth pole, flattened out and was vanned off after the finish. BAI BAI DUBAI steadied at the start and was outrun

thereafter. WINITBACK bothered at the start, was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and tired. INTREPID away in good order, displayed sluggish action a couple of jumps out of the gate and was always outrun. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
