Footnotes

INHERIT THE GOLD was unhurried during the initial stages, took the three path for the run around the second bend, was asked for some run bidding from there coming to the three-eighths pole, turned for home with a narrow lead and under much stronger handling, emerged from the furlongs grounds with a comfortable advantage and held sway, while kept busy to the end. YAWANNA TWIST sparred early with SPA CITY FEVER, under a good hold all the while, before willingly conceding the front upon leaving the opening turn, loosely stalked that opponent, was given some rein departing the backstretch to challenge for the lead in earnest, lost contact with the top one late on the far turn, despite being heavily encouraged, then continued on with good courage thereafter to secure the place. SPA CITY FEVER vied early with the runner up, with neither rival being asked for much speed, before zooming off to an open lead early down the backstretch, showed the way untested until midpoint on the far turn, gave in to the top one soon afterwards and weakened steadily during the last eighth. MINE OVER MATTER away alertly, was placed to a firm hold and taken back, took the inside route, was eased out coming to the five-sixteenths pole, swung wide into the stretch but lacked a kick. STUD MUFFIN brought up the back of the pack, was urged on the far turn, but made no gain.
