Footnotes

VERY CHERRY CANDY away well, knocked heads in hand with AMULAY through the first turn before conceding the front to angle to the outside of that foe five furlongs out, tracked the leader two to three wide, took closer order into the far turn, came under urging three furlongs out getting on nearly even terms at the head of the stretch, seized command at the three-sixteenths narrowly, dug in determined to hold sway and repulse that foe to the wire. AMULAY duelled from the two path in hand through the first turn, got conceded the front five furlongs out and shook away down the backside to the half mile pole, had her main pace foe issue challenge midway on the far turn, came under encouragement past the five-sixteenths, dug in under threat and was headed at the three-sixteenths, fought on inside through the length of the stretch but was held at bay while well clear of the rest and second best. PRIZE TAKER off half a beat slow at the start, raced three to four wide towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs from home, kept on evenly for the show while never threatening the top pair. ASCENDED FEVER tracked inside from afar, came under encouragement midway on the far turn, offered little response and weakened in the stretch. ROCK SHOW two to three wide in mid pack, angled four wide three furlongs out placed to a ride, continued four wide for home, weakened in the stretch. DARNLEY BAY chased two to three wide from mid pack, got spirited up at the three-eighths, offered no response and weakened in the drive. PORVOO stumbled at the start, took the overland route throughout and trailed.
