SPINIT TO WINIT kept watch on the front runners at or near the inside during the opening phases, slipped out and confiscated the two path away from WHITE CRANE at the five-sixteenths pole, got set down for the drive home, fought her way to a narrow advantage during the ensuing furlong, dug in well to preserve it. START IT UP sat reserved while racing towards the inside down the backstretch, picked up the pace when asked to early on the turn, angled three wide into the stretch, settled into her best stride and began to pick up real estate nearing the end of the furlong grounds, split rivals in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and got up for the place. WHITE CRANE raced from off the inside, was nudged into the three path by a more-determined foe coming to the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch slightly wider, held on well for the show. KILNOCKAGAIN had the pilot grab hold after ducking out at the start, contended for the lead from the two path, continued the fight with vigor to midstretch, then weakened. LITTLE MISS LUPE argued for command from the inside until upper stretch before backing away. EUROKAY BY ME three wide departing the backstretch, was through after going a half.
