WOULDN'T WE ALL quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, responded when set down turning for home, drew clear and was kept to a drive to remain safely clear to the finish. BRUSHED ON stumbled badly at the start but recovered quickly and pressed the pace from the outside then proved no match for the winner and continued on gamely to earn the place. ESTEEMED FRIEND showed good speed from the outside, raced three wide on the turn and lacked a solid finishing punch. DIAMOND, unhurried while between rivals early on, finished with good interest. KING ROLLER, never far back, raced inside and had no response when roused on the turn. ALBAHA, hustled inside, had no rally after an inside trip. MR. SINATRA raced four wide and had no rally.
