WON DOZEN ROSES raced close up early, rallied inside, dug in gamely on the rail and prevailed under a drive. BELLA ROUGE raced with the pace from the outside, rallied three wide on the turn and dug in gamely to the wire then was vanned off after the finish. LAST PUFF was outrun early, rallied inside and finished well despite some traffic problems in the stretch. HEAVENLY ROSE raced wide throughout and offered a mild rally outside. PAUGUS BAY was outrun early, raced inside and lacked a rally. IRISH GLORY was outrun early, put in a five wide run on the turn and faded in the final furlong. LADY STARS contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. HALFWAY TO HEAVEN chased the pace while four wide and tired. FORBIDDEN FRUIT contested the pace along the inside and tired.
