Footnotes

FREDDY THE CAP angled in after sprinted clear on the first turn, raced uncontested on the front in hand along the backstretch, shook loose in upper stretch and edged away while being kept to the task. OEDIPUS O'NEAL raced in good position along the rail for six furlongs, angled out in upper stretch, raced just behind the winner into deep stretch and narrowly held off WESTERN DEED for the place. WESTERN DEED steadied along the inside leaving the first turn, was under a firm hold along the backstretch, started out and angled back in on the far turn, angled three wide at the quarter pole then rallied belatedly after going back to the rail in midstretch. COMMISSIONER CHRIS was reserved for six furlongs while four wide and failed to threaten with a mild late rally. THUNDER MINISTER raced in traffic between horses on the first turn, raced in midpack, angled in on the far turn, saved ground to the top of the stretch and lacked a further response. THE ZIPSTER stumbled soon after the start, pressed the pace three wide, lodged a brief bid at the quarter pole and gave way thereafter. DEFREREOFTHEHEART was outrun while racing wide. TOP LEADER saved ground while never in contention.
