**Footnotes**

MILLER'S MINT angled in while taking charge on the turn, opened a wide gap in upper stretch and drew off while being kept to the task. BOB'S BIG HOPE lunged in the air and was bumped soundly at the start, was unhurried early, gained from outside on the turn, advanced three wide into the stretch and closed late to best the others. HONOUR ABOVE SELF broke outward causing crowding at the start, rushed up inside, saved ground for a half and weakened late. METINICUS was outrun to the turn, swung five wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. PAGING RYAN sprinted clear, relinquished the lead while bearing out badly on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. PATENT PENDING TOM was bumped soundly at the start and was never close thereafter. B D'S PHOENIX was bumped soundly at the start, moved up, bid turn, tired. BODY BLOWS never reached contention while saving ground. Z'S PITCH was pinched back and bumped at the start and never reached contention. ERNIE BOY raced in traffic along the inside on the far turn and gave way.
