FIVE SIXTEEN tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, was put to a prolonged drive upon reaching the far turn, availed of the opportunity to slip outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home three wide, fought his way to front, briefly between rivals in upper stretch, struck the front at the eighth pole then out dueled SUNS OUT GUNS OUT to prove best. SUNS OUT GUNS OUT sat parked two wide just off the leader's hind quarters for the opening half, moved up willingly to close the gap on the far turn, over hauled a more-energetically handled opponent to take over during the late stages of the run around the far turn, was set down, feeling some pressure from the top one in upper stretch, fell back slightly coming to the eighth pole, raced head to head with the winner the rest of the way, but got denied. STEELE ROAD three wide around both turns, held well to secure the show. ROUND MIDNIGHT underwent a three wide journey and was out finished. RUTHLESS ALLEY showed the way, rated along the inside until the three-eighths pole, was put to encouragement once the runner up drew abreast near the three-eighths pole, yielded nonetheless and steadily tired. SPORTING GENT off a beat slowly, was outrun. CAR TALK (IRE) placed near the inside throughout, failed to reach a contending position. An objection lodged by the rider of STEELE ROAD against the rider of FIVE SIXTEEN alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
