### Footnotes

TIGHTEND TOUCHDOWN hustled at the start, vied inside a rival until the five-sixteenths, shook clear of that foe under light coaxing while saving ground throughout the turn, turned for home safely clear, was roused at the three-sixteenths and went clear, saw his margin get cut into in the final sixteenth when in hand and geared down with the win not in doubt. KID WANDO broke in at the start making light contact with EXCITING MISSILE before being taken off that foe, came under a drive when angling to the inside of BLUE PUNCH near the five-sixteenths, displayed good energy through the lane no match for the winner while clearly second best. FRISKY WARRIOR coaxed along chasing the front from the two path, was briefly between rivals in the turn, came under a prolonged drive from the three eighths, offered up a mild bid for show honors while never a threat to the top twosome. EXCITING MISSILE bumped lightly at the start from his outside rival, was outrun in the initial going, made a three wide move on the turn into prominence at the head of the lane, couldn't sustain the bid in the latter stages of the stretch drive flattening out late while safely procuring the last major share. THOMAS HILL saved ground throughout, had to wait briefly approaching the three-sixteenths when in a bit tight along the rail, angled out at that station coming under a drive and offered no response. BLUE PUNCH broke well, vied for command in the two path, came under encouragement to keep pace at the three-eighths, got shaken off by the eventual winner midway on the turn and faltered. BRASS NOTE chased three to four wide on the turn from afar and was no factor.
