ZUCCHINI FLOWER strung out three wide on the opening bend, worked out a tuck closer to the rail upon entering the backstretch, sat under a good hold stalking the embattled pair just up ahead, continued to bide time until late on the far turn, responded positively when given her cue, splitting rivals coming to the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home from the two path and under a drive, narrowed in during the ensuing furlong, continued onward with good courage, getting the head down in time on the wire to prevail. WICKED MIZZ sped past the rivals to grab the early advantage, was guided over to the inside in plenty of time for the run around the first turn, got confronted by WHISPERDOWNTHELANE as a duel commenced, raced as a team with that foe down the backstretch, with several rivals, sitting well rated both from the rail and the outside in close proximity, continued along on the same scenario until the five-sixteenths pole, edged away to a clearer advantage at that station just as the top one was beginning to make her move, still held a healthy lead with an eighth to go, but with the winner starting to pick up ground more readily, dug in with good determination under good handling the rest of the way only to get nipped right at the finish line. LISA T. unhurried during the opening stages, picked up interest departing the backstretch, came four wide into upper stretch, made a mild run from upper to midstretch before flattening out. DOWN BY LAW stumbled badly at the start, took up position in midpack from off the inside, entered the second turn from the three path but was four wide by the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary response. WHISPERDOWNTHELANE floated four wide into the first turn, continued from off the rail to range up towards the pacesetter, sparred with the one from the outside for nearly three-quarters and gave way. HARD MYSTERY tracked the ongoing pace dispute from the inside under a good hold, came up empty when asked for a response.
