ERIN ENCHANTED vied for command from the inside, pilot atop with a firm hold on the reins for the initial three-quarters, edged away from the closest pursuers late on the far turn to enter the stretch with none latched on, was shaken up thrice vigorously with the reins before having stick work given for the first time, drew well clear, kept to a strong hand drive. GUYANA PRINCESS tracked the winner while taking the inside route, needed some encouragement by midpoint on the far turn to keep pace, entered the stretch under much stronger handling, angled outward, proved no match. QUIET SUNSHINE was lightly bumped from between rivals shortly after the start, raced from off the inside, was placed into the four path at the three-eighths pole, unleashed a run from there, closing the gap slightly after undergoing the effort, flattened out in the final eighth. CARAMEWAY was lightly bumped a short distance out of the starting gate, sat forwardly placed three wide around each bend, was under a drive spinning into the stretch, gave way. SALLY'S DREAM made light contact with QUIET SUNSHINE soon after the start, went on to assume a forward position, disputed the pace from the outside for nearly three-quarters, got shaken off and tired. ROYAL SUSPICION raced along the outside bringing up the rear of the pack, was under a protective hold approaching the quarter pole and got eased down the lane.
