**Footnotes**

PLATINUM BOMBSHELL away without apparent mishap at the start, contently kept watch on the runner up, well rated in the two path, picked up interest and latched on to that rival coming to the midway point on the far turn, crept up closer and closer to spin into the lane on nearly even terms, got set down for the drive, fought her way to a narrow advantage during the ensuing furlong, gradually extended it, kept to the task at hand. VINHDICATION SPOT out broke the field and had control established by the end of the run down the homestretch, tucked along the rail, set a couple of pedestrian initial splits, well rated and only loosely-pressed, drifted into the two path during the run around the second bend as the tempo quickened and as the top one was making her presence felt more and more, entered the lane getting put to the test by that one, yielded, held on well enough long enough to salvage second. FLAMINGO LANE shied inward slightly after bobbing at the start, made sustained, but light contact with ALWAYSINMYCIRCLE for a few strides right afterwards, tracked the front runners while saving ground, went around the far turn, departing each station having been put to more and more urging handling until placed to a full drive by the five-sixteenths marker, cut the corner into the lane with full clearance available, lacked a winning bid. ALWAYSINMYCIRCLE broke in a bit, leaned upon by FLAMINGO LANE for a brief period, raced between rivals on the second bend, had no rally. HOPE FOR TOMORROW swung three wide into the backstretch, remained as wide on the far turn, tired.
