Footnotes

MAMDOOHA away in apparent good order, settled in midpack, started the run around the turn from the two path, began to swing wider nearing the top of the lane until in the four path by the three-sixteenths marker, closed the gap rapidly to arrive at the eighth almost on dead even terms with both INSPIRED SAY EYE and SUSTAINABLE, took over shortly afterwards and edged away. SUSTAINABLE stalked the leader from the two path for a good portion of the way down the backstretch, ranged up to challenge that opponent in earnest as the half was being completed, fought with vigor during the ensuing furlong, failed to attain the front for good, but held on willingly to garner the place. ALPACA FINA raced three wide around the turn, departed the five-sixteenths pole having been asked for run, lost a tad of momentum nearing the furlong marker when the runner up, a short distance up ahead at the time, inadvertently drifted into the three path, altered course after going onward for slightly less than a sixteenth and mustered up some belated energy to grab the show. RED MINX got off a beat slowly, sat reserved for nearly a half towards the two path, was in the same one at the head of the stretch, kept pace while still on hold and lacking optimal racing clearance, managed to tip outward in the last sixteenth to gain it, flashed a mild kick thereafter for the last major check. INSPIRED SAY EYE kicked away from the competition during the initial stages, cut the pace, being rated along and kept at a slight distance from off the rail, came under assault from upper to midstretch, eventually succumbed and backed away. JONESIN FOR JERRY tracked the front runners while sitting the pocket, was under a hold upon reaching the half mile pole, awaiting suitable options, had the former pacesetter drift into the two path deep into the furlong grounds, squeezed by to launch a rally, flattened out. ROCK ME MAMA two wide departing the backstretch, was already under encouragement swinging from the five path into the stretch, made no impact.
