Footnotes

WHAT'S YOUR POINT was unhurried early on, advanced inside on the turn, came wide nearing the stretch, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. SWEET NOBILITY was outrun along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. EARHART chased the pace along the inside and was outfinished while drifting out in deep stretch. TAX THE QUEEN was bumped at the start, was outrun early, rallied inside and was going well late. CAVAN SUCCESS quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and faltered in the final furlong. ONE MEAN QUEEN was bumped at the start, raced inside and had no rally. ROAD TO TOWN raced wide and tired in the stretch. ARTISTIC EXPRESS chased the pace while three wide and tired. ALLISON'S APPROVAL stumbled at the start, was bumped and tired after showing brief speed.
