CHAKA BWANA came away well, and secured the pocket under her own power, was content to track the leader from that posefore tipping into the two path in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, crept up to the pacesetter, bid in earnest approaching the quarter pole, needed only a few strides after being straightened away to go on by, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage and maintained it under hand encouragement to the end. CATREIGN angled quickly over to the inside soon after the start, but for only a few jumps, being guided into the two path before reaching the half mile, was forced to continue the run around the bend three wide after the top one vacated the rail, swung wide for home under urging, made little headway on the winner, but continued on willingly to be well in front of the others for second. LADY OF THE FOREST away in good order, was moving along the inside when forced to check off CATREIGN's heels in the vicinity of the eleven-sixteenths pole, recovered and got going again, following the aforementioned rival to the outside soon afterwards, let the backstretch three wide but was strung out in the four path midway on the turn, was called upon entering the stretch but lacked the necessary response. VALUABLE LADY well rated setting the opening half from the inside, gave way readily by upper stretch, despite receiving strong right handed pressure. CIMINELLA was never involved. SARATOGA BLITZ got off to an awkward beginning and was through after a half. An objection lodged by the rider of LADY OF THE FOREST against the rider of CATREIGN alleging interference soon after the start was not allowed.
