SOLUTIONFINDERS in midpack during the initial stages, gradually ranged up to the front runner, was asked for some run at the five-sixteenths pole, kept pace with the leader during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward, making steady progress, wrested away the lead near the sixteenth pole and edged clear. HOLD THAT MEMORY rated in the two path during the opening half, responded well when put to strong handling in upper stretch, saw the advantage dwindle down leaving the eighth pole, relinquished it with about a sixteenth to go, but kept going well enough to secure second. FREUDIAN DILEMMA between rivals on the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. JUDY'S WARRIOR placed four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, rallied mildly to be up for the last major award. CELLA MUFLER improved position. AEGEAN STORM was no threat. BUDDY RED three wide and constantly nibbling on the bit, was through after completing a half. DIRT TRACK DEMON urged chasing, backing away approaching the head of the stretch. DR. TOM well off the inside, came outward a path or two midway on the turn and tired.
