Footnotes

THE NOZ off a beat slow at the start, made steady progress on the loose leader down the backside, collared that rival just past the midway point on the turn, got let out at the three-sixteenths, edged away to a safe advantage with an eighth to go, drifted from the left handed stick work by the rider in the late stages while having that margin cut into by the runner up. MACHO MUCHACHO allowed to settle along the inside bidding time from afar, improved position on the front through the turn under his own power, was set down at the head of the lane displaying a good kick for place honors. UNDERSTATEMENT hustled to the front, sprinted clear while along the inside, marshaled the field into the far turn with the eventual winner closing steadily, was displaced just past midway on the turn, came under a ride swinging for home, ran on through the stretch weakening in the late stages while safely clear for show. MARQUET REBEL broke out at the start, bumping lightly with ALCOMATCH, squeezing back TAKE DOWN TWO slightly at the start, loosely tracked the leader the closest pursuer early on, was pushed along to keep pace at the five-sixteenths, couldn't, tiring in the lane while along for the last major share. MY PIANO MAN bided time at the rear, came under a prolonged drive at the three-eighths pole and offered little. TAKE DOWN TWO pinched back at the break when his inside rival broke outwards, was allowed to settled towards the rear, saved ground throughout and was no factor. ALCOMATCH bumped lightly at the start by MARQUET REBEL who broke outwards, came under coaxing near the seven-sixteenths after chasing from afar, offered no response.
