### Footnotes

MAJESTIC HOPE secured a forward post after the start, pressed MOST HAPPY FELLA from the outside around the first turn and for a good portion down the backstretch, was allowed to ease back once ISCAR drew up to the pacesetter to take over the role of stalker, flip flopped paths with the previously mentioned rival coming to the half mile pole, kept within striking distance travelling three wide while making his way to the quarter pole, turned for home and was asked for run, challenged for command the widest of a trio at the eighth pole, with TOM CAT ALLIE doing likewise, but while making a rail run, and ISCAR between each foe, put away both of those opponents to take charge then dug in with good determination to fend off the runner up in the late stages. IRISH LION unhurried for the opening half, picked up the pace from midpoint on the far turn, entered the stretch under encouragement, was placed three wide at the three-sixteenths pole for better racing clearance, came home willingly to garner place honors. TOM CAT ALLIE along the outside, was put to a prolonged drive, ducked over to the inside prior to the quarter pole after clearing a now tiring MOST HAPPY FELLA, made a run from upper to midstretch to loom a bold threat with a furlong to go, but could not sustain the bid. ISCAR was forwardly placed three wide until the half mile pole, vied for the lead shortly after leaving the opening bend, tucked into the two path just reaching the end of the backstretch and soon took over the front, entered the stretch holding a slight advantage, came under heavy pressure from the inside and the outside during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds, yielded to it and steadily tired. TAP ATTACK swung three wide into the backstretch, remained well off the inside thereafter and failed to reach a contending position. MOST HAPPY FELLA out sprinted the field and was guided over to the rail, set the opening splits under constant pressure, gave way after going six furlongs. MAGICAL MYTH was through after going three-quarters.
