Footnotes

RIVER'S END sat forwardly placed from the three path around each bend, was let out a notch upon reaching the far turn and advanced towards the pacesetter, made her presence felt by the five-sixteenth pole, turned for home with her in front, drew out to a comfortable advantage during the ensuing furlong, maintained all of it, kept busy to the end. CLASS ACTION SUIT broke well and took the early lead, was rated at a slight distance from off the rail, kept under the watchful eye of LOUDER THAN SOUND, remained so until departing the backstretch, had the previously named foe fall behind a slight distance as the top one was in the process of drawing alongside, surrendered the lead as the two front runners were entering the stretch, was held together well enough down the lane to secure second. DESTINATION MOON was taken in hand off heels as LOUDER THAN SOUND was settling into the two path shortly before leaving the first turn, raced in midpack, between rivals for much of the way for the next half, angled three wide into upper stretch and rallied mildly for the show. LOUDER THAN SOUND made it into the two path entering the backstretch, rated kindly prompting the pacesetter until the seven-sixteenths pole, got asked for some run at that station, but could no longer keep pace. THREE BET raced three wide on both turns, failed to reach a contending position. I'M THE MIZZ off the inside, was placed four wide at the head of the stretch, had no offering to render. SHE'S A LISTENER got off last after striking the left side of the starting gate, made a dash towards the rail, appeared eager, despite a firm hold being applied on the reins by the pilot, en route to securing the pocket, stayed a forward factor for nearly three-quarters, then faded.
