Footnotes

WISE GUIDE in the three path on the opening bend, was tipped a bit wider soon after entering the backstretch, advanced into contention by the five-sixteenths pole, and got set down, drew out to a comfortable advantage from the head of the lane to midstretch, added to it, kept to the task at hand. STREET LORD brushed at the start, moved up willingly to secure a forward position, vied for command as the widest of three until past the midway point of the far turn, had the middle member drop back at this juncture only to get immediately replaced by the eventual winner, continued to fight for the lead, only now two wide and from between rivals until upper stretch, failed to keep up with the winner but held on well to secure second. CAT MAN FU rode the rail for nearly three-quarters, got angled outward and came home with good energy for the show, although never posing a threat to the top one. CASH YOUR TICKET quickly tucked along the inside route, was mildly shuffled during the middle stages of the run around the far turn, found space and squeezed to be two wide at the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch and was along for the last major check. JOE MOOCH tracked the pace dispute while saving ground, had no rally. PRIVATIZE along the inside, vied to maintained a slim lead pressed by at least two others, although not the same pair, until upper stretch, faltered. DARK ROAST strung out three wide on the first turn, remained well off the inside throughout, was through after completing three-quarters. KATMANSTU came out a couple of steps, but was pulled off the nearest foe in time to avoid making any contact, raced from off the rail and was through by the quarter pole. JACK'S LION off the inside, was never involved. BIG BRESY made light contact with STREET LORD at the start, disputed the pace from between rivals until near the five-sixteenths pole, then gave way.
