PAPA TOM assumed a forward position in the initial stages, stalked the pacesetter towards the two path, was under some light urging upon departing the backstretch, felt the whip by the five-sixteenths marker, entered the stretch, had READTHESMOKESIGNAL get asked for run soon afterwards, surged by that rival nevertheless to take charge, edged away. ANAPHYLAXIS sat reserved for nearly three-quarters, got placed four wide at the top of the lane and mustered up a good response to rally for the place. CALL FOR THE CLOCK saved ground, arrived at the five-sixteenths pole having been roused, got outfinished. LEMANSKY underwent a three wide pursuit on the far turn, was considerably wider by the head of the stretch, backed away. READTHESMOKESIGNAL broke well, cleared the field and was taken over towards the inside, showed the way, being rated from just off the rail on a loosely-contested lead, remained with none latched on coming to the quarter pole, despite all the main pursuers having been put to solid encouragement by this point, was a few strides into the stretch run before getting asked for run himself, quickly got overhauled by the winner and gave way. PURE ATTITUDE three wide on the opening bend, remained from off the inside although a bit closer to the rail thereafter, was no factor. JAMES JINGLE was outrun off a ground-saving journey.
