Footnotes

EVERYDOGHASHISDAY rode the rail, appeared eager tracking the front runners, pulling with some force on the bit for a good portion of the opening half, was given his cue cutting the corner with sufficient clearance along the inside corridor to launch his rally, did so, whittled away at the advantage, traded head bobs with TAKE THE EL TRAIN late, winding up at the wire in a dead heat. TAKE THE EL TRAIN broke alertly, took command and settled towards the inside, cut the pace, being rated and kept at a slight distance from off the rail, continued along on the same scenario for six furlongs, drifted into the two path for the commencement of the stretch, got set down, felt the presence of EVERYDOGHASHISDAY down along the fence with an eighth to go, dug in with determination in the late stages but had to settle for a tie for first. CANDY RAIDER three wide on the opening bend, was strung out one path wider on the subsequent one, weakened in the final furlong. PATRIOTIC DUTY off the inside throughout, departed the backstretch in the three path, wedged between rivals, got asked for some run after slightly more halfway around the second bend, remained in contention before flattening out with an eighth to go. SONNYANDPALLY gave chase from the two path, tired. DUCKS DOCK off sluggishly, darted over to the inside, saved ground for nearly three-quarters, fanned five wide into upper stretch, had no offering. NELSON AVENUE three wide on the opening bend, never reached prominence.
