SPARTIATIS took up the chase from afar and from well off the inside down the backstretch, drifted out slightly nearing its end, carrying out MR. TICKER TALKER momentarily, was placed in the two path shortly afterwards, picked up ground during the later stages of the run around the bend, with the loose leader starting to exhibit signs of vulnerability, entered the stretch full of run and under a full drive, brushed with the runner up deep into the furlong grounds, emerged at the eighth pole holding a clear advantage, extended it kept busy to the end. COST AFFECTIVE sat loosely pocketed for the initial half, raced in tandem with the top one as the pair gained ground readily on FRAME after going more than halfway around the turn, cut the corner into the lane but soon abandoned the inside route by tipping out outwards towards the two path, brushed with the winner in midstretch, finished willingly for the place although proving no match. MR. TICKER TALKER was carried out slightly and for only a brief period by SPARTIATIS as they headed for the end of the backstretch, followed that rival and was put into the two path shortly afterwards, was maneuvered wider and set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. FRAME was grabbed hold after coming in a bit at the start, was put to brisk hand urging to clear a tightly-packed bunch and take command right afterwards, drew well clear, continued on the lead, from the rail and unopposed, increasing the lead out to its biggest between the first and second calls, had the top twosome began to close in rapidly approaching the quarter pole, got called upon spinning into the lane, surrendered about a furlong later and faltered. SIMPLY MAS arrived at the end of the backstretch in the two path, unsettled and rankly pulling on the bit, tucked along the rail thereafter and tired off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
