MS. SYLVIA A. gained the early advantage, put away FASHIONATION before completing the half to arrive at the quarter pole holding a healthy advantage, was asked for some run and scampered away, crossing the wire being hand urged. JILLY MAC was bumped at the start, departed the backstretch from the three path, drifted outward much more after entering the stretch, rallied for the place. CRAZY OVER EASY broke awkwardly, was quickly placed along the rail and rode it to past the furlong marker, got outfinished. FASHIONATION in the two path, gave way after chasing the winner for almost a half. FROSTY LOVER gently pinched after getting lightly bumped from both sides, was in the two path and getting roused by the half mile pole, failed to respond. JUST CATTY bumped at the start, failed to pick up interest despite some early stick work in the area of the right shoulder, raced primarily from off the inside and gave way.
