PRECIOUS FRANCA lost her footing at the break, settled into two path, was forced to remain on hold heading for the quarter pole, stuck behind rivals and lacking any suitable options, gained no relief from the predicament during the opening phase of the stretch drive, had some room to launch a rally deep into the furlong grounds and was given her cue, split rivals with a furlong to go, continued onward steadily cutting into the margin, altered course to be outside the runner up late and got there. RAVEN RISE away last after ducking in as the field was sent on its way, responded to some light hand urging and rushed up along the rail to grab away the advantage, wasn't asked for run thereafter while continuing on the front end, arrived at the quarter pole having drifted into the two path, just as a swarm of potential closers had gathered behind, got put back to encouragement, lost little if any of the lead during the ensuing furlong, began to drift back towards the outside once more, got reeled in during the final seventy yards. BLUE SIXTY FOUR tracked the pacesetter from the pocket, turned for home with sufficient room along the inside corridor to launch a rally, got outfinished. PURLING underwent a four wide pursuit on the bend, lacked the needed late response. JEALOUS three wide entering the turn, swung five wide exiting it, had no rally. MISS SILVER BIRCH vacated the inside route after taking it for most of the way down the backstretch, raced mostly three wide on the turn, fanned into the six path entering the stretch, tired. FLY SOLO disputed the pace from the two path early and gave way.
