### Footnotes

KEESLER contested the pace along the inside, responded when roused in upper stretch, drew clear and remained clear under a drive. ACE'S CAPPELLA was bothered after the start, contested the pace while three wide and continued on gamely to hold the place spot. SPECIAL TACTICS raced with the pace along the rail, was shuffled back nearing the turn, raced inside and had no rally. SURREY DOWN was taken up along the inside entering the turn, raced inside and lacked a rally. KINGS EMPRESS had no response when roused. MISS DISCOVER contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. A general Stewards' inquiry resulted in no change in the order of finish. A claim of foul against the winner by the rider of the second place finisher, alleging interference after the start, was dismissed.
