Footnotes

DR DISCO away in good order, moved up willingly into a forward position, vied for the lead, the widest of three, and with none of the participants in the pace dispute being called upon for run, spun into the lane, on nearly even terms with BAMBI BOUND, brushed lightly with FIERY FOOTWORK before commencing to rally in earnest, forged to the front upon reaching the eighth pole, then edged away during the final furlong, under good handling. KATSKILL BAY was coaxed along in the two path, keeping pace with the ongoing pace dispute, angled outward in upper stretch and finished willingly to be along for the place. FIERY FOOTWORK vied between rivals for much of the going, dropped back a bit as the threesome approached the quarter pole, brushed with the top one spinning into the lane, continued onward, hesitated a bit when the path between the pair just up ahead tightened up, got going again in short order and held his ground well to the finish line to grab the show. BAMBI BOUND was guided over to the inside coming to the half mile pole, continued taking the inside route while vying with another two rivals, perched just to the outside, remained a prominent factor until midstretch, got displaced and steadily weakened thereafter. MAKE NOTE outrun for nearly a half, turned for home under a drive and improved position belatedly. SYSTEM RESTORE raced in midpack, followed BAMBI BOUND over to the inside, tucking along the rail in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, stayed within range, cut the corner into the lane, chose to hug the rail after settling into upper stretch, maintained position from the three-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole as best as he could, stuck treading behind BAMBI BOUND clogging up the inside and lacking any opportunity to angle outward to freedom, gained some room to wiggle into the two path upon reaching the sixteenth pole, but was kept on hold, still lacking optimal racing clearance and the time needed to attempt any additional maneuvers to gain it. DR. W saved ground until the quarter pole. DIGGER KARAKORUM raced three wide and tired. CAJUN JET inside until the quarter pole, was outrun.
