SOVEREIGN DEFAULT away in good order, pressed REIN KING from the inside in the initial stages, conceded the front to that rival upon reaching the backstretch, content to take up the role of stalking from the two path, continued to bide time for nearly three-quarters, picked up interest late on the second turn and angled three wide into upper stretch, rallied in unison with COSMIC KING towards the leader during the run through the furlong grounds, collared him with about a sixteenth to go, won a hard fought fight with the second place finisher to prove best. COSMIC KING settled along the inside soon after the start,sat reserved while patiently tracking the front runners, got asked for a response and gave it, launching a sustained run from the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner full of momentum, was guided over into the two path a short way into the stretch drive, without missing a beat, gained ground on REIN KING as a team with the top one, going by in the vicinity of the sixteenth, showed good determination to the end, but had to settle for the place. REIN KING broke running, gradually worked his way to a clear advantage and was sent over to the inside midway down the backstretch, had PERSON OF INTEREST make his presence felt nearing the half mile pole, yet remained under rating tactics, was let out a notch and kicked free of the competition coming to the quarter pole, appeared vulnerable by the eighth pole with the top twosome bearing down hard, yielded to their combined challenge a sixteenth down the road, held well to secure the show. PERSON OF INTEREST was placed three wide shortly after entering the backstretch, went by the eventual winner and tucked into the two path just before reaching the far turn, briefly prompted the pacesetter before backing away. VOTER three wide heading to the end of the homestretch made it into the two path in time for the run around the opening bend, was taken to the rail at the seven-sixteenths pole and asked to pick up the pace, came up empty. CINNAMON BEACH raced along the outside and was through after completing three-quarters.
