LAILA'S JAZZ raced three wide,.was set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, closed the gap on the pacesetter, took control shortly after entering the stretch and drew clear. WILD FINISH got off a beat slowly, was near the inside for most of the way down the backstretch but in the two path for the start of the run around the bend, fanned outward until five wide into the stretch, displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to procure the place. STONELY THE LONELY chased the front runners from near the two path, got called upon for the stretch, lacked the needed response. IN HARM'S WAY made contact with SATURDAY APPEAL at the break, kicked away to arrive at the end of the backstretch on an open lead, cut the pace, under a firm hold by the pilot from the two path on the turn, felt pressure coming from a fully revved up LAILA'S JAZZ, was let out in response to the impending challenge, relinquished without putting up much resistance and backed away. SATURDAY APPEAL bumped between rivals at the start, chased along the outside and tired. ROCKET HERO was grabbed hold after taking a step inward at the start, was three wide entering the turn and four wide leaving it, failed to menace. MEEKER AVENUE saved ground, was put to a long hard drive, faded.
