STAR OF SARAVA off to an alert beginning, cleared a much more urgently-asked foe racing down homestretch to take command, tucked along the inside, faced light resistance coming from the closest pursuers for most of the opening three-quarters, got called upon for the drive home, reached the wire in time to successfully fend off the second place finisher. REAL ESTATE rated in the pocket, vacated it turning for home, gained steadily on the winner in the final furlong, but fell short. HOPPY DO rode the rail, picked up interest when asked to leaving the midway point on the second bend, was already being roused cutting the corner into the lane, altered course to be outside the front runners a sixteenth later, got outfinished. CLASSIC R AND B prompted the top one from the two path, began to losing contact at the three-eighths pole. AWAKE AT T WIRE somewhat reluctant to load, proceeded to break without apparent mishap, raced from off the inside throughout, departed the backstretch from the three path, lacked the needed response. HOLY INVADER strung out four wide on the first turn, was slightly closer to the rail on the next one, was through after completing three-quarters. DESERT DON JUAN travelled in the three path on the opening bend, remained off the rail while never making his presence felt, drifted six wide into the stretch while tiring. TAXPLAYER put to brisk encouragement leaving the gate, lost out on the early advantage to the more confidently-handled winner nonetheless, chased that rival from the two path, tired then was eased down the lane.
