MAGDALENA BAY contested the lead from between rivals during the initial stages, had the runner up, the innermost member of that three way tussle get taken back, got placed along the irail and resumed the fight one on one with CAPERS N WINE afterwards, shook free during the later stages of the run around the bend, got set down entering the stretch, held on well to prevail. ROSEMARIE was involved with the pace until midpoint down the backstretch, got taken back, picked up interest when asked to more than halfway around the turn, angled outward as the half was being completed, made up some ground. MISS GLORY was pulled away from CAPERS N WINE after making solid contact with that opponent, got placed along the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, was along for the show off the subsequent ground-saving journey. RICE AND BEANS saved ground for nearly a half, got fanned into the six path coming to the three-sixteenths marker to no avail. CAPERS N WINE bumped at the start, assumed a forward position nevertheless, was the widest of three disputing the pace for much of the opening furlong, sparred from the two path with the top one nearly all the way around the turn backed away.
