Footnotes

PENTHOUSE PARTY kept watch on the front runners from the pocket, under a snug hold by the pilot during the early stages of it, picked up interest when asked to a short distance from the quarter pole, entered the stretch, went onward for a little while longer before altering course several paths to the outside, drifted slightly wider shortly afterwards, chopped away at the lead held by the runner up with a furlong remaining, had that opponent drift so far to the outside so as to be directly alongside in the late stages, had no significant contact occur though, won the late duel to prove best. VOID raced from off the rail throughout, sat forwardly placed in the three path around the far turn, issued a challenge heading for the top of the lane, worked her way to the front, began to drift outward noticeably, at times after being put to some left handed stick work, raced in close quarters with the winner during the last stages, battled gamely but lost both the lead and the photo. LUMINEUSE cut the pace being rated along the inside, was put to the test after six furlongs had been run, yielded but remained a prominent factor to the eighth pole before backing away. MILKYOURWAY rated in the two path while stalking the pacesetter for three-quarters, tired. GLASSY ALY gently pinched back to last after being lightly bumped from both sides right after the start, rode the rail to about midway on the far turn, failed to get motivated despite feeling the whip both at the half mile pole and later on a furlong down the road. SOUL OPPOSITION bumped several times at the start, travelled four wide on the far turn, failed to menace. BEBES PASSION underwent a few bumps at the start, was in three path and asked for a response at the three-eighths pole, didn't offer any.
