FORTUNATE RUN ideally placed on the outside behind the ongoing pace dispute, was coaxed along to maintain position, took off after the surviving front runners late on the turn, availed of a sizeable hole between rivals, splitting them to continue the bid at the quarter pole, stuck the front, getting the head down at the eighth pole to grab the lead, then edged clear, driving. TIMBER CRUISE urged to the front, fought for command, from the inside, with another pair of rivals, was seemingly coming out on the short end of the dispute, before staging a mild comeback during the stretch drive to grab second. LITTLE WISE GUY forwardly placed four wide around the turn, held his ground well to the end en route for the show. SAINTS ALIVE bumped with FAYOUM at the start, raced into a forward position soon afterwards, left the backstretch three wide, vied for command, the outermost member of a threesome, grabbed control approaching the quarter pole, surrendered it to the top one at the furlong marker and flattened out. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN always inside, was always no factor. FAYOUM was bumped at the start, sparred between rivals until the five-sixteenths pole and tired.
