QUIET MAN sat reserved from off the inside in midpack, felt the stick on the right shoulder and picked up the pace late on the far turn, commenced his stretch run three wide at the head of the lane, made up ground on the pacesetter during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward, collared the leader in the final seventy yards and edged away, being hand urged all the while. LITTLE WYATT shot out of the gate and opened up a quick two on the field, fought noticeably against the bit proceeding down the homestretch, entered the first turn and seemed to stride more professionally thereafter, was a short way down the backstretch when he drifted into the two path, was at times a bit wider making his way to the quarter pole, entered the stretch and got turned loose, emerged from furlong grounds still in possession of a comfortable advantage, saw it dwindle down steadily thereafter, got caught past the sixteenth pole, but held on well for the place. FREUDIAN THERAPIST contently tracked the pacesetter from the inside for nearly three-quarters, was given his cue and made an abbreviated run at the leader coming to the quarter pole, angled outward turning for home, but soon flattened out. BIG BUDGET broke outward slightly at the start, raced while unhurried from off the inside, swung four wide into upper stretch, lacked a solid closing punch. A CAT THAT FLIES devoid of early foot, loped along while racing near the inside, angled out after settling into upper stretch, was set down to a drive and flashed belated interest en route to out finishing a tiring rival for minor spoils. JACKIN MY STYLE saved ground and was through after completing three-quarters.
